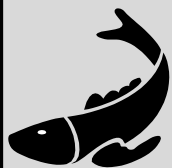
Columbian Ladies Guild, *By Darlene Catazaro, President.*

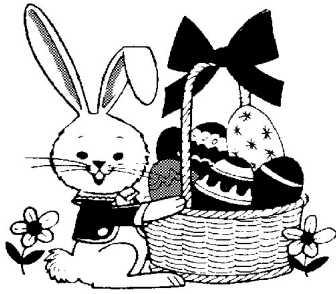
