Way back in 1843 nine priests of the Congregation of the Most Precious Blood from Germany came through Massillon. Their leader was Father Frances Brunner. They stayed with the Schmidt family. While they were in Massillon they offered Mass in the Schmidt home and heard Confession of the German speaking residents. The people begged them to stay- or at least one of them- but they were committed to go to Cincinnati at the request of Bishop Purcell.

Eventually we had Brunnerdale Seminary in our area and many young men of our area became priests of the Most Precious Blood. It is fortunate that we have the street Brunnerdale Avenue named for Father Brunner.

There is a beautiful website entitled: Devotion to the Most Precious Blood. I urge you to download it and to pray to the Most Precious Blood during this crucial month in the history of our land.


