I believe we all realize the plight of Catholics in the Middle East. So many of them have been driven out of their homes by ISIS. Men, women and children are faced with a search for somewhere to lay their head and to find a piece of bread so that they can stay alive. So far we Knights of Columbus have provided four million dollars to help them but they still need more. Our Supreme Council has secured a large number of olive wood crosses. They are five inches in size and have been made by Christian craftsmen in the Holy Land and they are beautiful.

I was so impressed by members at our last Council meeting. They are willing to help to offer these crosses to individuals in our area. The cost is ten dollars for a cross and the entire amount will be sent to the Knights of Columbus Refugee Relief Fund. On page two of this newsletter there are names and phone numbers of our Council officers. I invite you to phone me or any one of these officers to secure one or many of these olive wood crosses. You and I can make a difference for our fellow Christians who are being left with almost nothing. Let's do our part to make their crosses a little easier to carry.
